

INFORMATION: SCIP Database 15. JANUARY.2021

The SCIP-Database is legal requirement established under the European Waste Framework Directive, in which "…companies supplying articles containing substances of very high concern (SVHCs) on the Candidate List in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) on the EU market have to submit information on these articles to ECHA, as from 5 January 2021…".

The SCIP-database was made available in October 28th 2020 and from January 2021 on, it will be the basis for information on articles containing Candidate List substances throughout the whole lifecycle of products and materials, including at the waste stage, making information more transparent to waste operators and consumers.

Sonae Arauco makes its REACH declarations available on the website https://www.sonaearauco.com/en/downloads-494.html under the item "Certifications".

These declarations affirm, that our wood-based products do not contain any of the SVHC (substances of very high concern) on the Candidate List (available at https://www.echa.europa.eu/de/candidate-list-table) in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) and as such, our products are not subject to registration in the SCIP-database.

We confirm that, in case any of our products change and would fall under this regulation's requirements, the necessary entries will be made in the SCIP-database established pursuant to Article 9 Paragraph 2 of Directive 2008/98/EC on waste (Waste Framework Directive) before its first delivery and the client will be informed.
